

The Private Security Industry Act(2001) was brought in to set maintain and raise the standards of the UKs private security industry. It created a new organisation called the security industry authority, an independent body reporting to the home office secretary, to reduce crime, raise standards and recognise quality services.

The SIA has three main duties

1. The compulsory licensing of individuals undertaking designated activities within the private security industry , any individual working within security roles must have a license.
2. To keep under general review the private security industry and the operation of the legislative framework.
3. To set and approve standards of conduct, training, and supervision within the industry and to make recommendations to improve standards.
